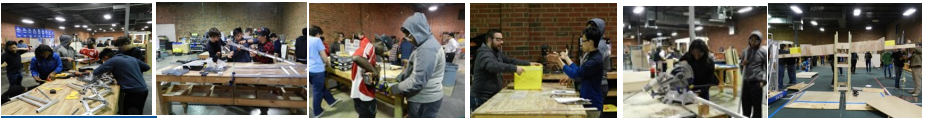

First Power UP Kick-Off at Discovery Place, Charlotte



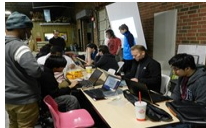

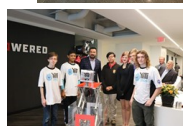
